RETURNING EXHIBITOR REQUESTING THE SAME SPACE - DEADLINE: JULY 1, 2009

Please familiarize yourself with the rule changes, regulations and guidelines as outlined in this brochure.

I understand my entry is not transferable. I acknowledge the Exhibitor guidelines and agree to abide by them:

SHOW GUIDELINES AND ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Send four (4) slides or photos representative of your work, including one of your entire booth set-up. Please clearly mark your name and category on back of photos or on the slide frame. (These will be returned at check in.) Check must accompany entry form with a self-addressed business size envelope and adequate return postage. This is required. Jury deadline is July 17, 2009. No refunds after August 7, 2009.
2. **Please do not bring merchandise that has not been juried.** All booth assignments are final. Exhibitors **MUST** stay within designated areas and **ALL** aisles are to remain clear. **Fire Laws Require This.**
3. All booths must have adequate merchandise for sale. No "order only" booths allowed.
4. Tables must be covered to the floor. Displays cannot exceed 7 1/2 feet high. Backdrops are provided. (Pipe & Drape) Enclosures enhance your booth and prevent unwanted backgrounds from the booths around you. All boxes and carriers must be removed or out of sight. Exhibitors furnish all pegs, hooks, heavy extension cords and tape. Unload and move vehicles to exhibitor parking North of the building before setting up display.
5. You are responsible for collecting your own sales tax which is 4.5% state, 4% city and .3% county. (8.8%)
6. No band saws or noise makers allowed.
7. Set-up time; You may check in and set up Friday, September 18, 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. or Saturday, September 19, 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. All exhibits in place and ready to open no later than 9:30 a.m. Saturday. You are responsible for all unloading and loading. Vehicles must be moved to parking area by 9:00 a.m. Saturday - NO EXCEPTIONS.
8. Building security Friday and Saturday night. Festival committee will not be responsible for unattended booths. Volunteers will be available to booth sit for short breaks on Saturday and Sunday.
9. There will be a variety of food vendors on site.
Don't forget to use your complimentary food vouchers!
10. All sales will be handled by exhibitors and no commissions will be charged. Wear name tag at all times, please. Additional name tags on request.
11. Not responsible for theft, accident or any damage occurring at the Festival or Civic Center Complex.
12. Absolutely no food or beverages sold from exhibitor's booths.
13. Confirmation or rejection will be mailed after August 11. Checks will be held until this time.

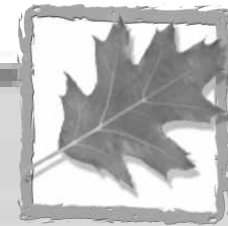

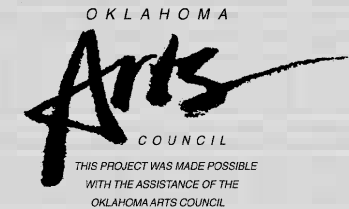
